Did You Know?

1958 - Highlands High School opens its doors.

2007 - Highlands High School is renamed Highlands Academy of Arts and Design and incorporates the former junior high school, Don Julio Junior High.

2010 - Highlands Academy of Arts and Design reverts its name back to Highlands High School. It also starts a 2 year process back to being a 9 - 12 comprehensive high school and receives the School Improvement Grant (SIG).



Challenging Schoolwide Goals for Student Achievement

Highlands High school will reduce the percentage of students who are non-proficient on the California Standards Tests in both English Language Arts and Mathematics by 10% or more from the prior year. To do so, teachers will record and analyze quarterly student achievement data and work intensely with specific non-proficient students.

To monitor progress toward meeting these goals, Highlands will need to develop student assessment benchmarks and timelines for each quarter.

Working Together - Making a Difference

The Alumni Association's was founded in 2009, and since then we have accomplished a lot. We started with Highlands' 50th Anniversary Gala celebration, created floats and rode them in the Memorial Day Parades, raised and donated thousands of scholarship dollars to graduating seniors, beautified the campus with the Memorial Gardens, participated in the N.H. Jubilee, donated annually to B.E.S.T. and the baseball teams. We have also been instrumental in bringing alumni together at our parties and keeping them informed when a classmate has passed. Currently we have members working on the school's History Museum, the 2014 Golf Tournament "Swing for Scholarships", and the Memorial Day Parade. Everyone is invited to participate, but if you want to make a difference by serving on the Board, then we have an opportunity for you.




